WHO ARE WE?


BASED IN THE historic university town of Oxford, England, the Crisler Library Oxford Ltd. was set up to cultivate and preserve the works of bible scholar and archaeological enthusiast, B. Cobbey Crisler, who was once president of the Daycroft School. Sadly, Cobbey passed in the 1980s but his wife has tirelessly worked to establish the Crisler Library in Ephesus which has now evolved into the Crisler Library, Oxford Ltd. and is used to promote his scholarship worldwide. The Ashmolean Museum, Oxford, now has in its collections a rare copy of the Abgar inscription donated by Janet Crisler and this reflects the depth of scholarship and research taking place at sites across the Mediterranean and Middle East during Cobbey's fascinating career.


WHAT DO WE DO?


WE ARE A private library, accessible to international scholars, researchers and students who may contact us to arrange study periods referencing Cobbey Crisler's works and other volumes in our collection. To subsidise this unique resource, we have established a bookshop which sells the entire collection of Cobbey's talks, brought together for the first time in its entirety. With a set of CDs running to twenty-seven volumes and over twenty volumes of his transcribed talks, we are now able to offer archival footage of Cobbey speaking and are hoping to bring more of these to life on DVD. There are currently three talks from vintage film available.

Cobbey's name is well established within Christian Science circles and with a dedicated readership among those who recall and were enriched by his erudition, we retain a keen following. We would like this readership to flourish, bringing Cobbey's original thinking in this sphere alive for future generations of Christian Scientists and to make those currently unfamiliar with his message now aware of what his unique story has to offer.
