For week of April 15 - 21, 2013 Doctrine of Atonement

1 Jo 4:10 NLT - This is real love--not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

1Jo 2:1 NLT - My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous.

1Jo 2:2 NLT - He himself is the sacrifice that atones for our sins--and not only our sins but the sins of all the world.

1Jo 2:3 NLT - And we can be sure that we know him if we obey his commandments.

1Jo 4:8 NLT - God is love.

1Jo 4:9 NLT - God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him.

1Jo 4:14 NLT - Furthermore, we have seen with our own eyes and now testify that the Father sent his Son to be the Savior of the world.

1Jo 4:15 NLT - All who confess that Jesus is the Son of God have God living in them, and they live in God.

1Jo 4:16 NLT - We know how much God loves us, and we have put our trust in his love. God is love, and all who live in love live in God, and God lives in them.

1Jo 4:17 NLT - And as we live in God, our love grows more perfect. So we will not be afraid on the day of judgment, but we can face him with confidence because we live like Jesus here in this world. 1Jo 4:19 NLT - We love each other because he loved us first.

1Sa 15:22 NLT - "What is more pleasing to the LORD: your burnt offerings and sacrifices or your obedience to his voice? Listen! Obedience is better than sacrifice, and submission is better than offering the fat of rams.

Isa 43:3 NLT - For I am the LORD, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.

Isa 43:4 NLT - because you are precious to me. You are honored, and I love you.

1Cr 8:6 NLT - there is only one God, the Father, who created everything, and we live for him. And there is only one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom God made everything and through whom we have been given life.

Jhn 1:17 NLT - For the law was given through Moses, but God's unfailing love and faithfulness came through Jesus Christ.

Jhn 10:23 NLT - He was in the Temple, walking through the section known as Solomon's Colonnade.

Jhn 10:24 NLT - The people surrounded him and asked, "How long are you going to keep us in suspense? If you are the Messiah, tell us plainly."

Jhn 10:25 NLT - Jesus replied, "I have already told you, and you don't believe me.

Jhn 10:27 NLT - My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

Jhn 10:28 NLT - I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me,

Jhn 10:29 NLT - for my Father has given them to me, and he is more powerful than anyone else. No one can snatch them from the Father's hand.

Jhn 10:30 NLT - The Father and I are one."

2 Jo 1:9 NLT - anyone who remains in the teaching of Christ has a relationship with both the Father and the Son.

Mar 12:32 NLT - there is only one God and no other.

Mar 12:33 NLT - And I know it is important to love him with all my heart and all my understanding and all my strength, and to love my neighbor as myself. This is more important than to offer all of the burnt offerings and sacrifices required in the law."

Mat 4:23 NLT - Jesus traveled throughout the region of Galilee, teaching in the synagogues and announcing the Good News about the Kingdom. And he healed every kind of disease and illness.

Mat 5:1 NLT - One day as he saw the crowds gathering, Jesus went up on the mountainside and sat down. His disciples gathered around him,

Mat 5:2 NLT - and he began to teach them.

Mat 5:17 NLT - "Don't misunderstand why I have come. I did not come to abolish the law of Moses or the writings of the prophets. No, I came to accomplish their purpose.

Mat 5:22 NLT - I say, if you are even angry with someone, you are subject to judgment!

Mat 5:23 NLT - "So if you are presenting a sacrifice at the altar in the Temple and you suddenly remember that someone has something against you,

Mat 5:24 NLT - leave your sacrifice there at the altar. Go and be reconciled to that person. Then come and offer your sacrifice to God.

Mat 7:28 NLT - When Jesus had finished saying these things, the crowds were amazed at his teaching,

Mat 7:29 NLT - for he taught with real authority-quite unlike their teachers of religious law.

2Cr 5:20 NLT - We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!"

2Ch 30:9 NLT - the LORD your God is gracious and merciful. If you return to him, he will not continue to turn his face from you."

Mar 2:15 NLT - Later, Levi invited Jesus and his disciples to his home as dinner guests, along with many tax collectors and other disreputable sinners. (There were many people of this kind among Jesus' followers.)

Mar 2:16 NLT - But when the teachers of religious law who were Pharisees saw him eating with tax collectors and other sinners, they asked his disciples, "Why does he eat with such scum?"

Mar 2:17 NLT - When Jesus heard this, he told them, "Healthy people don't need a doctor--sick people do. I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners."

Jhn 8:1 NLT - Jesus returned to the Mount of Olives,

Jhn 8:2 NLT - but early the next morning he was back again at the Temple. A crowd soon gathered, and he sat down and taught them.

Jhn 8:3 NLT - As he was speaking, the teachers of religious law and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in the act of adultery. They put her in front of the crowd.

Jhn 8:4 NLT - "Teacher," they said to Jesus, "this woman was caught in the act of adultery.

Jhn 8:5 NLT - The law of Moses says to stone her. What do you say?"

Jhn 8:6 NLT - They were trying to trap him into saying something they could use against him, but Jesus stooped down and wrote in the dust with his finger.

Jhn 8:7 NLT - They kept demanding an answer, so he stood up again and said, "All right, but let the one who has never sinned throw the first stone!"

Jhn 8:8 NLT - Then he stooped down again and wrote in the dust.

Jhn 8:9 NLT - When the accusers heard this, they slipped away one by one, beginning with the oldest, until only Jesus was left in the middle of the crowd with the woman.

Jhn 8:10 NLT - Then Jesus stood up again and said to the woman, "Where are your accusers? Didn't even one of them condemn you?"

Jhn 8:11 NLT - "No, Lord," she said. And Jesus said, "Neither do I. Go and sin no more."

Hbr 13:9 NLT - So do not be attracted by strange, new ideas. Your strength comes from God's grace,

Mar 6:34 NLT - Jesus saw the huge crowd as he stepped from the boat, and he had compassion on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things.

Mat 9:2 NLT - Some people brought to him a paralyzed man on a mat. Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "Be encouraged, my child! Your sins are forgiven."

Mat 9:3 NLT - But some of the teachers of religious law said to themselves, "That's blasphemy! Does he think he's God?"

Mat 9:4 NLT - Jesus knew what they were thinking, so he asked them, "Why do you have such evil thoughts in your hearts?

Mat 9:5 NLT - Is it easier to say 'Your sins are forgiven,' or 'Stand up and walk'?

Mat 9:6 NLT - So I will prove to you that the Son of Man has the authority on earth to forgive sins."

Then Jesus turned to the paralyzed man and said, "Stand up, pick up your mat, and go home!"

Mat 9:7 NLT - And the man jumped up and went home!

Mat 9:8 NLT - Fear swept through the crowd as they saw this happen. And they praised God for sending a man with such great authority.

Mat 9:37 NLT - "The harvest is great, but the workers are few.

Mat 9:38 NLT - So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields."

Jhn 17:1 NLT - After saying all these things, Jesus looked up to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son so he can give glory back to you.

Jhn 17:6 NLT - "I have revealed you to the ones you gave me from this world. They were always yours. You gave them to me, and they have kept your word.

Jhn 17:11 NLT - Holy Father, you have given me your name; now protect them by the power of your name so that they will be united just as we are.

Jhn 17:26 NLT - I have revealed you to them, and I will continue to do so. Then your love for me will be in them, and I will be in them."

Act 2:22 NLT - "People of Israel, listen! God publicly endorsed Jesus the Nazarene by doing powerful miracles, wonders, and signs through him, as you well know.

Act 2:23 NLT - But God knew what would happen, and his prearranged plan was carried out when Jesus was betrayed. With the help of lawless Gentiles, you nailed him to a cross and killed him.

Act 2:24 NLT - But God released him from the horrors of death and raised him back to life, for death could not keep him in its grip.

Act 2:25 NLT - King David said this about him: 'I see that the LORD is always with me. I will not be shaken, for he is right beside me.

Act 2:26 NLT - No wonder my heart is glad, and my tongue shouts his praises! My body rests in hope.

Act 2:27 NLT - For you will not leave my soul among the dead or allow your Holy One to rot in the grave.

Act 2:28 NLT - You have shown me the way of life, and you will fill me with the joy of your presence.'

 $Act\ 4:33\ NLT\ -\ The\ apostles\ testified\ powerfully\ to\ the\ resurrection\ of\ the\ Lord\ Jesus,\ and\ God's\ great\ blessing\ was\ upon\ them\ all.$

Rom 5:11 NLT - we can rejoice in our wonderful new relationship with God because our Lord Jesus Christ has made us friends of God.

- Eph 2:4 NLT God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much,
- Eph 2:5 NLT that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!)
- Eph 2:6 NLT For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.
- Eph 2:10 NLT For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.
- Eph 4:7 NLT he has given each one of us a special gift through the generosity of Christ.
- Eph 4:13 NLT This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.
