admit - (S3 - SH 26:23) - [Macmillan Dictionary] to agree that something is true

advocate - (RR - 1 John 2:1) - [NW1828] One who defends, vindicates, or espouses a cause. In scripture, Christ is called an advocate for his people.

animated - (S3 - SH 26:14) - [OLQD] having life or vigor or spirit

assimilate - (S8 - SH 4:20) - [OLQD] take up mentally.

atone - (S6 - SH 19:4) - [NW1828] to reconcile

atonement - (S6 - SH 18:13) - [Science and Health p. 22] The atonement requires constant self-immolation on the sinner's part. That God's wrath should be vented upon His beloved Son, is divinely unnatural. Such a theory is man-made. The atonement is a hard problem in theology, but its scientific explanation is, that suffering is an error of sinful sense which Truth destroys, and that eventually both sin and suffering will fall at the feet of everlasting Love.

[Science and Health p. 18] the exemplification of man's unity with God, whereby man reflects divine Truth, Life, and Love.

[Wordsmyth] in Christian Science, the state of oneness between man and God.

aught - (B9 - Matthew 5:23) - [OLQD] a quantity of no importance

begotten - (RR - 1 John 4:9) - [OLQD] (of offspring) generated by procreation

blasphemeth - (B17 - Matthew 9:3) - [NW1828] To speak of the Supreme Being in terms of impious irreverence; to revile or speak reproachfully of God, or the Holy Spirit. To arrogate [assume] the prerogatives [exclusive or peculiar privileges] of God.

celestial - (S3 - SH 26:17) - [NW1828] Heavenly; belonging or relating to heaven;

conciliate - (S6 - SH 18:18) - [NW1828] To reconcile, or bring to a state of friendship

confess - (RR - 1 John 4:15) - [NW1828] To own; to acknowledge; to declare to be true

countenance - (B19 - Acts 2:28) - [KJD] appearance.
[Strong's] face, presence.

creed - (S14 - SH 135:27) - [Wordsmyth] a formal statement of religious principles; any formulated system of principles, beliefs, or opinions

devoid - (S1 - SH 134:15) - [NW1828] not possessing;

divers - (B15 - Hebrews 13:9) - [NW1828] Different; various.

efficacious - (S21 - SH 497:14) - [NW1828] Effectual; productive of effects; producing the effect intended; having power adequate to the purpose intended; powerful;

efficacy - (S11 - SH 19:20) - [NW1828] Power to produce effects; production to the effect intended; as the efficacy of the gospel in converting men from sin; the efficacy of prayer;

encompassing - (S17 - SH 496:19) - [Webster 1913] To circumscribe or go round so as to surround closely; to encircle;

exemplification - (S2 - SH 18:1) - [NW1828] a showing or illustrating by example.

fervent - (S8 - SH 4:3) - [OLQD] sincerely or intensely felt

homage - (S2 - SH 18:5) - [NW1828] Reverence directed to the Supreme Being; reverential worship; devout affection.

irreconcilable - (S6 - SH 19:6) - [NW1828] That cannot be made to agree or be consistent; incongruous; incompatible;

manifested - (B18 - John 17:6) - [Wordsmyth.com] demonstrated

meekness - (S8 - SH 4:4) - [NW1828] Softness of temper; mildness; gentleness; forbearance under injuries and provocations. In an evangelical sense, humility;

pang - (S11 - SH 19:17) - [NW1828] Extreme pain; anguish; agony of body; as in spasm, or childbirth.

perfect - (RR - 1 John 4:17) - [NW1828] Complete in moral excellencies. (spiritually mature); Finished; complete;

persecution - (S14 - SH 136:7) - [CDofAE] to treat (someone) unfairly or cruelly over a period of time because of their race, religion, etc.

potent - (S22 - SH 67:23) - [Wordsmyth] having strength; powerful. producing strong effects,

propitiation - (GT - 1 John 4:10) - [KJD] Covering; atoning sacrifice.

quicken - (B22 - Ephesians 2:5) - [NW1828] To make alive in a spiritual sense;

reconciled - (B11 - 2 Corinthians 5:20) - [Wordsmyth] to overcome differences and restore a relationship between.

repentance - (B13 - Mark 2:17) - [Wordsmyth] the feeling of sorrow or deep regret for something done in the past.

requisite - (S24 - SH 11:23) - [OLQD] anything indispensable; necessary

self-immolation - (S7 - SH 23:5) - [IP] voluntary sacrifice or denial of oneself, as for an ideal

species - (S15 - SH 494:5) - [OLQD] a specific kind of something

stead - (B11 - 2 Corinthians 5:20) - [NW1828] replacing or filling the place of another

wast - (B2 - Isaiah 43:4) - [OLQD] The second person singular of the verb "be", in the indicative mood, imperfect tense; -- now used only in solemn or poetical style. See "Was".

waxed - (S1 - SH 134:14) - [NW1828] 1. To increase in size; to grow; to become larger; 2. To pass from one state to another; to become;

wrought - (S16 - SH 202:4) - [NW1828] Worked; formed by work or labor;
