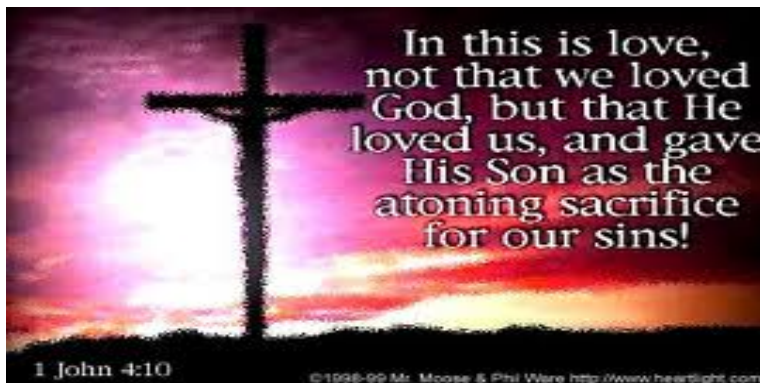


**Golden Text I John 4:10**

He did this by giving us a truer sense of \_\_\_\_\_. This redeems us from the law of matter.

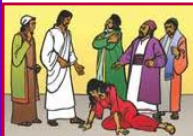
S&H 7 23:1-5 The atonement doesn't happen only once. It is a c\_\_\_\_\_ giving up of mortal error for Truth.

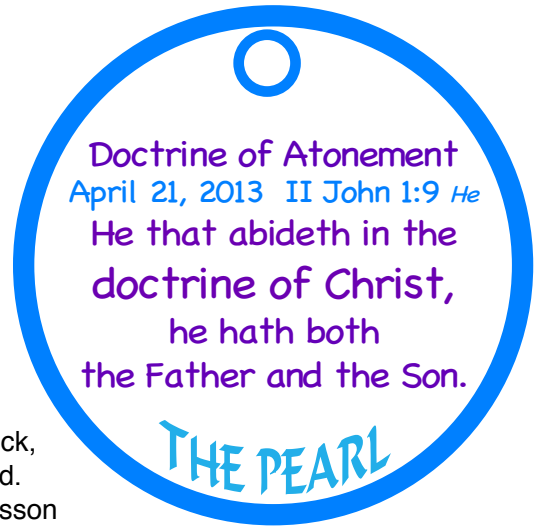
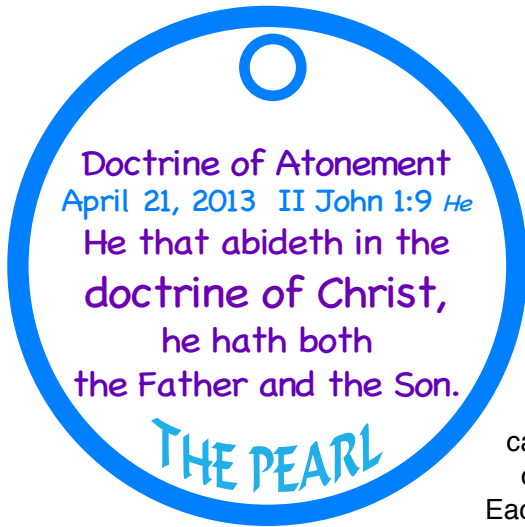
