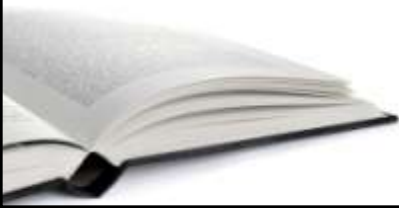

Purpose of the Expressive Reading Workshop:

The Expressive Reading Workshop is a continuation of our focus on Church Alive through activities that will strengthen our branches' viability as vibrant and useful elements within our Christian Science movement. To that end, we are happy to invite you to a presentation on Readership and reading, both of which play vital roles in the prosperity of Christian Science, in our individual spiritual progress, and in Christian healing.

The Workshop presentation includes:

- An exploration of:
 - The importance of effective studying and reading.
 - Why Readers and students should study the principles of reading aloud.
 - The real and simple role of Readers.
 - Barriers to effective reading—what they are; why it's important to identify them; and how to remove the shackles they attempt to impose on our reading and studying.
 - The standards of effective reading—straight from the Holy Bible and our Leader, Mary Baker Eddy.
 - How to set God's word free from the pages on which it was written.

- We'll examine two sets of tools:
 - Tools for Understanding:
 - Both silent and oral readers learn how to:
 - Improve their scholarly understanding of the text, and to elevate that scholarly understanding to more spiritual dimension of heart-felt understanding of God's word.
 - Identify clues writers have left—clues that reveal important insights into God's inspiration to them.
 - Pay special attention to the nuances created by the writer's choice of words and the structure of their writing.
 - Gain a clearer and deeper understanding of the heart and soul of the writer's work.
 - Tools for Delivery:
 - Though most apparently beneficial to oral Readers, these tools can greatly enrich the silent readers' comprehension, and help members of the congregation support the efforts of their Readers. Readers will learn how to:
 - Use all our God-given communication tools to the best of our abilities.
 - Deliver inspired messages with the same depth of feeling and richness of expression with which the writer might have actually spoken the words.
 - Eliminate self-consciousness and learn how to “get themselves out of the way” – while freely expressing themselves.
