#### **Golden Text:**

Ps 75: <sup>1</sup> We thank You, O True God. Our *souls are* overflowing with thanks! Your name is near; Your people remember and tell of Your marvelous works and wonders.

### **Responsive Reading:**

Ps 40: <sup>5</sup> You have done so many wonderful things, had so many *tender* thoughts toward us, Eternal my God, that go on and on, ever increasing. Who can compare with You?

Ephesians 2: 10 For we are the product of His hand, heaven's poetry etched on lives, created in the Anointed, [Christ] Jesus, to accomplish the good works God arranged long ago. <sup>20</sup> You are being built on a solid foundation: the message of the prophets and the voices of God's chosen emissaries [apostles] with Jesus [Christ], the Anointed Himself, the precious cornerstone. <sup>21</sup> The building is joined together stone by stone—all of us chosen and sealed in Him, rising up to become a holy temple in the Lord. Eph 3: 14 It is for this reason that I bow my knees before the Father, <sup>15</sup> after whom all families in heaven above and on earth below receive their names, and pray: <sup>16</sup> Father, out of Your honorable and glorious riches, strengthen Your people. Fill their souls with the power of Your Spirit <sup>17</sup> so that through faith [Christ], the Anointed One will reside in their hearts. May love be the rich soil where their lives take root. May it be the bedrock where their lives are founded so that together <sup>18-19</sup> with all of Your people they will have the power to understand that the love of [Christ], the Anointed is infinitely long, wide, high, and deep, surpassing everything anyone previously experienced. God, may Your fullness flood through their entire

beings. <sup>20</sup> Now to the God who can do so many *awe-inspiring things, immeasurable things,* things greater than we ever could ask or imagine through the power at work in us, <sup>21</sup> to Him be all glory in the church and in Jesus [Christ], the Anointed from this generation to the next, forever and ever.

#### Section 1

- **1.** Isa 45: <sup>5</sup> I am the Eternal One; there is no other God but Me, and even though you don't know Me, I am preparing you *for victory*.
- **2.** Ps 104: <sup>24</sup> There is so much here, O Eternal One, so much You have made. By the wise way in which You create, *riches and* creatures fill the earth. <sup>30</sup> When You send out Your breath, life is created, and the face of the earth *is made beautiful* and is renewed.

#### Section 2

- **3.** Isa 40: <sup>5</sup> The Lord will be, really be, among us. The radiant glory of the Lord will be revealed. All flesh together will take it in. Believe it. None other than God, the Eternal, has spoken.
- **4.** Gen 1: **God**: <sup>3</sup> Let there be light. And light flashed into being. <sup>4</sup> God saw that the light was *beautiful* and good, and He separated the light from the darkness. <sup>5</sup> God named the light "day" and the darkness "night." Evening gave way to morning. That was day one. **God**: <sup>26</sup> Now let Us conceive a new creation—humanity—made in Our image, fashioned according to Our likeness. And let *Us grant* them authority over all the earth—the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, the domesticated animals and the *small* creeping creatures on the earth. <sup>27</sup> So God did *just that*. He created humanity in His image, created them male and female.

**5.** Job 32: <sup>8</sup> It is the spirit in a man, *not age*, and the breath of the Highest One [Shaddai] *within him* that lends understanding.

#### **Section 3**

- **6**. Job 33: <sup>4</sup> God's Spirit has fashioned me and the breath of the Highest One [Shaddai] imparts life to me.
- 7. Jer 1: 4... the Eternal One *first* spoke to me: 5 **Eternal One:** Before I even formed you in *your mother's* womb, I knew all about you. Before you drew your first breath, I had already chosen you to be *My* prophet *to speak My word* to the nations.
- **8.** Isaiah 43: **Eternal One:** *Remember* who created you, O Jacob? Who shaped you, O Israel? *See,* you have nothing to fear. I, *who made you,* will take you back. I have chosen you, named you as My own. <sup>5-6</sup> So don't be afraid. I am here. I will reunite you with your children, bringing them back from wherever in the world they are—East, West, North, or South. *No place will be able to hold you when* I demand your release, when I order them, "Bring *My children*—My sons and daughters—from far away. <sup>7</sup> Bring the ones who are called by My name; the ones I made, shaped, and created for My *profound* glory."
- **9.** Ps 145: <sup>10</sup> All creation will stand in awe of You, O Eternal One. Thanks will pour from the mouths of every one of Your creatures; Your holy people will bless You.

#### **Section 4**

10. Jer 2: The word of the Eternal came to me again.

11 Has a nation ever exchanged its gods for some others, even if they weren't really gods in the first place? But My beloved people have done just that: they have exchanged their glory to pursue worthless idols in their vain attempt for greater prosperity. 
13 My people are guilty of two evils: They have abandoned

- Me, the spring of living waters; And instead, they have settled for dead and stagnant water from cracked, leaky cisterns of their own making.
- **11.** Gal 3: <sup>3</sup> Are you so foolish? Do you think you can perfect something God's Spirit started with any human effort?
- 12. Isa 45: 8 Skies above, open up and let the clouds rain down righteousness! Let the earth below sprout triumph and justice. For I, the Eternal, have created them. <sup>11</sup> So the Eternal One, who is the Holy One and Maker of Israel, says, **Eternal One**: *Are you really going to* question Me about what will happen to My children, or lecture Me about what I should do with the ones I made with My own hands?
- **13.** Isa 40: <sup>26</sup> Look at the myriad of stars *and constellations* above you. Who set them to burning, *each in its place?* Who knows *those countless lights* each by name? *They obediently shine*, each in its place, because God has the great strength and strong power to make it so.

#### **Section 5**

- **14.** Ps 138: <sup>8</sup> The Eternal will finish what He started in me. Your faithful love, O Eternal One, lasts forever;
- **15.** Ps 86: <sup>7</sup> When times of trouble come, I will call to You because *I know* You will respond to me. <sup>10</sup> For You are great, and Your works are wondrous; You are the one True God.
- 16. John 12: Jesus (crying out before the people):

  44 Anyone who believes in Me is not placing his faith in Me, but in the One who sent Me here. 45 If one sees Me, he sees the One who sent Me. 46 I am here to bring light in this world, freeing everyone who believes in Me from the darkness that blinds him.

**17.** Matt 8: <sup>14</sup> Jesus went to Peter's house, and there He saw Peter's mother-in-law lying in bed, sick and burning up with a fever. <sup>15</sup> Jesus touched her hand, and *then she was healed*—the fever vanished. She got up from bed and began to wait on Him.

#### **Section 6**

- **18.** Matt 9: <sup>35</sup> Jesus went through many towns and villages. He taught in their synagogues. He preached the good news of the kingdom of God. He healed every disease and sickness. <sup>36</sup> Whenever crowds came to Him, He had compassion for them because they were so deeply distraught, malaised, and heart-broken. They seemed to Him like lost sheep without a shepherd. <sup>37</sup> *Jesus understood what an awesome task was before Him*, so He said to His disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. <sup>38</sup> Ask the Lord of the harvest to send more workers into His harvest field."
- **19.** Matt 10: Jesus called His twelve disciples to Him. He endowed them with the authority to heal sickness and disease and to drive demons out of those who were possessed.
- **20.** Luke 9: **John:** <sup>49</sup> Master, we found this fellow casting out demons. He said he was doing it in Your name, but he's not one of our group. So we told him to stop. **Jesus:** <sup>50</sup> *What?* No! Don't think like that! Whoever is not working against you is working with you.
- **21.** Luke 10: The Lord then recruited and deployed 70 more disciples. He sent them ahead, in teams of two, to visit all the towns and settlements between them and Jerusalem. <sup>17</sup> When the 70 completed their mission and returned to report on their experiences, they were elated. **Seventy:** It's amazing, Lord! When we use Your name, the demons do what we say!

Jesus: <sup>18</sup> I know. I saw Satan falling from above like a lightning bolt. <sup>19</sup> I've given you true authority. You can smash vipers and scorpions under your feet. You can walk all over the power of the enemy. You can't be harmed. <sup>20</sup> But listen—that's not the point. Don't be elated that evil spirits leave when you say to leave. Rejoice that your names are written in heaven.

#### **Section 7**

- **22.** Rev 3: <sup>7</sup> ... "These are the words of the holy One, the true One, and the One who possesses the key of David, which opens *the possibilities* so that no one can shut them. The One who closes *all options* so that no one can open: <sup>8</sup> "I know your deeds. See, I have placed before you an open door, which no one can shut.
- 23. Acts 5: 12 Those were amazing days—with many signs and wonders being performed through the apostles among the people.... <sup>17</sup> Of course, this popularity elicited a response: the high priest and his affiliates in the Sadducean party were jealous, <sup>18</sup> so they arrested the apostles and put them in the public prison. 19 But that night, a messenger of the Lord opened the doors of the prison and led them to freedom. Messenger of the Lord: 20 Go to the temple, and stand up to tell the people the whole message about this way of life from Jesus. 21 At dawn they did as they were told; they returned to their teaching in the temple.... 34 but Gamaliel, a Pharisee in the council respected as a teacher of the Hebrew Scriptures, stood up and ordered the men to be sent out so the council could confer privately. Gamaliel: 35 Fellow Jews, you need to act with great care in your treatment of these fellows. <sup>38</sup> So here's my advice: in this case, just let these men go. Ignore them. If this is just another movement arising from human enthusiasm, it will die out soon enough. 39 But then again, if God is in this, you

won't be able to stop it—unless, of course, you're ready to fight against God! <sup>42</sup> And constantly, whether in public, in the temple, or in their homes, they kept teaching and proclaiming Jesus as [Christ], the Anointed One, the Liberating King.
